Bright Beginners

Tuesdays & Thursdays, 12:30pm – 3:30pm

Class is available to 3-4 year olds. Child must be potty trained.

LEARNING DETAILS:

Bright Beginners will have approximately a 1:8 teacher/student ratio. Kids will be focusing on early reading and writing skills, letter, color, number and shape recognition, and social skills including sharing, listening, and working together.

ACTIVITY:

Bright Beginners will have 2 swim lessons and 2 Gym Monkeys classes each month on alternating weeks to keep Swim Instructor/Student ratios low and safe for the kids. There will also be active play time daily.

TUITION:

\$120 per month for Granite Members/\$155 per month for Non-members

Little Learners

Monday/Wednesday/Friday, 12:30pm – 3:30pm

Class is available to 4-5 year olds. Child must be potty trained.

LEARNING DETAILS:

Little Learners will have approximately a 1:10 teacher/student ratio. Kids will be focusing on fine motor skills including writing their name, lower and uppercase letters, numbers, as well as reading, math, and social skills, and getting prepared for kindergarten.

ACTIVITY:

Little Learners will have 2 swim lessons and 2 Gym Monkeys classes each month on alternating weeks to keep Swim Instructor/Student ratios low and safe for the kids. There will also be active play time daily.

TUITION:

\$155 for Granite Members/\$185 for Non-members

Payment: Tuition is due by the 1st of each month. *The first tuition payment will be due October 1st, and final payment due May 1st.* Our billing will be set up through automatic billing. If you prefer not to pay via automatic billing, you can pay tuition with check, cash, or credit card no later than the 1st. Our programs operate from the Tuesday after Labor Day until the Thursday before Memorial Day. Tuition rates have been set keeping in mind school closings such as holidays and conferences, as well as special events. Tuition paid is non-refundable. There are no discounts granted for inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances, absences, or vacations.

Registration: An annual, non-refundable registration fee of \$35.00 per child PLUS first month's tuition (non-refundable), along with the registration form below, is needed to reserve your child's place in our program. Registration is accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Once your registration is processed, you will receive an email confirming your child's enrollment. Prior to the first day of school, you will receive the additional paperwork required. You will need to turn in your child's vaccination records in addition to this paperwork.

How did you learn about Granite's Early Education Program? _____

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Purpose/Goals: Granite's Early Education Program's primary goal and purpose to provide an active learning environment in which teachers and students experience an enthusiasm for learning and accomplish successes. We promise to provide the children with ample opportunities to grow socially, physically, emotionally, intellectually, and creatively in our child centered environment.

Curriculum: Granite's Early Education Program offers an academic and intellectual based, hands-on curriculum that incorporates language arts, math, science, creative art, and early reading skills throughout weekly lesson plans. Children will enjoy a circle time (which includes the Pledge of Allegiance), small group projects, physical activity, music and free choice time throughout their daily routine.

Snack: We will have a snack time each day. Please provide a healthy snack each day that is easy for the child to open. **No juice/soda/candy.** Please make sure your child has eaten a good lunch so they won't be immediately hungry as snacks are planned for around 2pm each day.

Ratios: The student to teacher ratio will maintain approximately a 1:8 in the Bright Beginners Classes, and 1:10 in the Little Learners Program.

Facilities: The Early Education Program will be taking place mostly in the Granite Kids' Club. We will use the basketball gym that is directly connected to the Kids Club for active play time and for Born to Move Classes. On the designated swim days, kids will enter through the Ladies Locker Room and go to the back area where there is a large changing area. There will be an instructor on hand to help them change if needed.

Staff: All staff, including the Director, Teachers, Teacher's Aides, and Activity Instructors will be trained in First Aid and CPR. All staff in the facility are trained in CPR as well.

Families: Families play an important role at our school. Families are welcome to participate as a volunteer, suggest ideas, and contribute talents to our program. We invite you to communicate with the staff on a daily basis regarding your child's education and general well-being. If there is ever a grievance matter involving any of our families, staff, or programs, those involved are encouraged to speak to the Program Director Jenn Thompson *immediately*.

School Calendar: The Early Education Program will begin Tuesday September 4th, 2018 and will end Thursday May 23rd, 2019. Our schedule will operate using the calendar of School District 2 as a guideline for holidays and vacations.
